ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

It is expressly agreed that all play in the this Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament shall be undertaken by players at their sole risk, and the City or La Vernia nor the La Vernia Lions Club shall not be subject to any claim, demand, or for any loss, damage, injury, or death caused to any player, player's family or guest, from any cause whatsoever. Every player, for himself/herself, and on behalf of his/her spouse, children, guest, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, does hereby expressly forever release and discharge the City of La Vernia nor La Vernia Lions Club, its agents, employees, successors and assigns, for all such claims, demands, injuries, damages, rights or causes of accident.

It is further agreed that as a participant in the league, tournaments, and special events, we the undersigned knowingly and voluntarily assume any and all risks inherent to our participation and agree to abide to all regulations established by the City of La Vernia and La Vernia Lions Club rules. Further more, the City of La Vernia nor La Vernia Lions Club shall not be responsible for articles lost, stolen or damaged in the tournament or on the premises.

PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1) The Team Captain will be responsible for the conduct of all the players, and the players shall be responsible for the conduct of all the teams' spectators. Any player that is ejected from the game for unsportsmanlike conduct must leave the park.
- 2) No player may verbally harass an opposing player or spectator or say things that could promote ill feeling between the two teams or their spectator. No player may continuously argue with an umpire or make comments regarding an umpire's call or lack of a call. This includes making comments about how an umpire calls the game. In each game, the team or player may be given one warning, and if such conduct shall continue, a player or players can be ejected from the game for unsportsmanlike conduct, and escorted off the City property.
- 3) Any player who uses foul language at an umpire or City/ La Vernia Lions Club representative can be ejected from the game and escorted off City property for unsportsmanlike conduct with out being given a warning.
- 4) Any player who is involved in unsportsmanlike aggressive behavior towards another player or spectator shall be ejected from the game and escorted off City property. Any act by a person which is determined as being

detrimental to the tournament, will result in that person being escorted off City property.

- 5) No player or their spectators may bring any type of glass container into the park.

Co-Ed Rules

- 1) MATCHES CONSIST OF THE BEST 2 OUT OF 3 GAMES
- 2) GAMES ARE TO 25 POINTS (MUST WIN BY 2 POINTS) RALLY SCORING. TYPE OF GAME PLAY WILL BE DETERMIND ON THE AMOUNT OF TEAMS WE GET SIGNED UP. 7 OR LESS TEAMS WE WILL PLAY ROUND ROBIN. 8 OR MORE TEAMS WILL BE A POOL PLAY TO SET UP THE BRACKET, PLAY OFF WILL BE SINGLE ELIMINATION; ALL RALLY SCORING. (POOL PLAY WILL BE ONE MATCH RACE TO 30 (MUST WIN BY 2 POINTS))
- 3) IN PLAY OFF, TIE-BREAKERS (3RD GAME) ARE RALLY POINT; SCORE ON EVERY SERVE, FIRST TEAM TO 15 (MUST WIN BY 2 POINTS)
- 4) BACK LINE PLAYER CANNOT COME UP TO FRONT-LINE TO SPIKE OR BLOCK: ONE EXCEPTION – IF A TEAM HAS ONLY 2 GUYS PLAYING (4 GIRLS/2 GUYS) THEN THE **GUY** IN THE BACK MAY HELP **BLOCK** ON THE NET. THIS EXCEPTION DOES NOT APPLY TO TEAMS WITH 3 GUYS
- 5) ROTATION ORDER MUST BE MAN, WOMAN, MAN, ETC
- 6) TEAMS OF 6 PLAYERS MUST BE MADE UP OF: 3 MEN & 3 WOMEN, 2 MEN & 4 WOMEN; OR 1 MAN & 5 WOMEN
- 7) TEAMS OF 4 PLAYERS MUST BE MADE UP OF 2 MEN & 2 WOMEN, 1 MAN & 3 WOMEN
- 8) UPON RETURNING THE BALL, MORE THEN 1 HIT, A WOMAN MUST HAVE CONTACT OF THE RETURNED BALL. (MAN HIT, MAN HIT, WOMAN MUST HIT IT OVER); (MAN HIT, WOMAN MUST HIT IT OVER). SINGLE HIT OVER DOES NOT MATTER.
- 9) OFFICIATING WILL BE DONE BY EACH TEAM. IF RECEIVING, YOU CALL IN OR OUT. IF YOU HAVE A DISAGREEMENT, A REPLAY WILL APPLY.
- 10) YOU MAY SERVE ANYWHERE BEHIND THE SERVICE LINE. PLEASE WATCH YOUR FOOTING WHEN SERVING.
- 11) NO BLOCKING ON SERVES (“BLOCKING IS THE ACTION OF PLAYERS CLOSE TO THE NET TO INTERCEPT THE BALL COMING FROM THE OPPONENT BY REACHING HIGHER THAN THE TOP OF THE NET. ”)
- 12) A SERVE THAT HITS THE TOP OF THE NET AND FALLS IN IS A GOOD SERVE

- 13) YOU MAY CROSS THE CENTER LINE AS LONG AS YOU DON'T INTERFERE WITH THE OPPOSING TEAM (Interfering results in a side out)
- 14) YOU MAY NOT TOUCH THE NET DURING PLAY. (Side out Results)
- 15) IF THE BALL HITS THE OUT OF BOUNDS MARKER IT IS A GOOD BALL
- 16) IF A BALL HITS ANY PART OF YOUR BODY AND GOES OVER, IT IS A GOOD BALL, AS LONG AS IT HITS YOUR BODY ONCE.
- 17) **NO KICKING THE BALL**, THIS IS NOT INSIDE VOLLEYBALL
- 18) EACH TEAM WILL BE ALLOWED 1 TIME OUTS PER GAME, KEEP IT UNDER 2 MINUTES.
- 19) SUBSTITUTIONS – MAN FOR MAN, WOMAN FOR WOMAN
- 20) FORFEIT – YOU HAVE 10 MINUTES AFTER GAME TIME, BEFORE A FORFEIT IS CALLED; YOU ONLY FORFEIT THE FIRST MATCH, NOT THE WHOLE GAME.
- 21) **YOU MUST BE 16 YEARS OLD TO PLAY IN LEAGUE OR TOURNAMENT, 14, 15 YEAR OLDS WILL BE ALLOW TO PLAY THIS TOURNAMENT; WITH AND ONLY WITH PARENTS SIGNATURE ON ROSTER, ANY QUESTION ABOUT A PERSONS AGE, ID WILL BE ASKED FOR. IF WISHING TO PLAY, PLEASE HAVE IDENTIFICATION AVAILABLE UPON REQUEST FOR PLAYER AND PARENTS.**
- 22) SERVER MUST CALL “SERVICE” BEFORE SERVE.
- 23) **BAD LANGUAGE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. IF THE BAD LANGUAGE GETS OUT OF HAND AND OTHER TEAMS ARE COMPLAINING ABOUT THE TEAM USING THE BAD LANGUAGE A WARNING WILL BE GIVEN, IF THE BAD LANGUAGE CONTINUES THERE WILL BE NO MORE WARNING, POLICE WILL BE CALL TO HAVE THE TEAM ESCORTED OFF THE PRIMISES. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON THE ENTRY FEE. CONSIDER THIS YOUR FIRST WARNING.**
